

Directions Museum Visit

- For the protection of the works, bags, umbrellas and other bulky objects larger than A4 format should not be taken into the rooms of the museum, neither should articles of clothing be carried over the arm. Free cloakroom lockers are provided.
- Please keep a proper distance to the works and please do not touch them.
- The Art Museum Graubünden provides folding chairs. Please always carry these in your hand and not over your shoulder.
- Taking photos without flash is allowed provided the work carries no notice to the contrary. Selfie (handy)-sticks and tripods are not allowed.
- Drinking and eating within the museum rooms is not permitted. Food and drink can be had at the museum café.
- Visitors with children are requested not to leave these unattended. Running about is not allowed anywhere in the museum. Smaller prams (buggies) are permitted.
- For writing notes within the museum rooms pencils and writing pads are ready for you at the reception.
- Walking aids (not umbrellas) and wheelchairs are permitted. Wheelchairs and walkers are available at the reception.
- Animals are not allowed in the museum except for guide dogs with guide frames.
- Please follow the instructions of the security staff at all times. Visitors who disturb
 exhibition operations can be requested to leave the premises by the museum staff.

Additional Regulations for Groups and School Classes

- Those responsible for groups/classes should see to it that the groups or classes behave in a respectful manner, and they should inform these prior to the visit about the regulations described above. Passages must remain clear at all times.
- Please guide school classes through the museum as a closed group. Sitting on the floor is allowed.
- Classes with more than 10 students should be accompanied by two persons.
